**Job location:** Municipality of Peja

**Duration:** 1 Year (3 months Prohibition Period)

**About the project:** The YEEP II project targets young people from the rural and urban areas of Peja, and aims to provide young people with the skills and knowledge to enter the labor market, as well as to inform them of job opportunities that may be suitable for them and their abilities.

Within this project, young people will be equipped with a comprehensive set of life skills, young people will be offered professional mentoring, and practical work, and will be encouraged to come up with business ideas, which if successful will be funded by the project.

**Main responsibilities:**

- Organizes youth/project activities;
- Be involved in YEEP II project 100%, and be in charge of organizing the activities and expenditures in line with the project manager.
- Organizes weekly meetings and training for youth (digital & physical);
